Operations Technician Responsibilities:

- Inventory and stock control of fireworks, equipment and show supplies utilizing in-house database software
- Preparing fireworks/special effect shows including vehicle loading/unloading
- Building, and repairing of equipment and effect supports/holders
- Regular maintenance and quality control of company assets including: show and rental equipment; vehicles (owned / leased); light facility maintenance
- Overall assistance of fireworks and special effects operations/logistics and other duties as assigned
- Keeping all company facilities organized and clean
- Ensuring compliance with all Federal, State, and Local regulations
- Reliable transportation; Valid driver's license required
- Must be authorized to work in the United States and possess a Class B Commercial Driver License with airbrakes and Haz-Mat endorsement (or able to obtain within 45 days of employment)

Characteristics and Traits of Operation Technicians:

- Must possess strong time management skills, be punctual, and reliable while adjusting to constant changes in priorities
- Good computer skills and proficient in Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, PowerPoint) and ability to learn database and company systems software
- Highly organized, detail oriented with excellent communication skills, able to follow written and verbal instructions and able to preserve confidential and sensitive information
- Self-starter with ability to be efficient, and work quickly and accurately either independently or as part of a team environment under pressure, amid distractions and interruptions, while maintaining a positive attitude
- Electrical, plumbing, and "general contractor" skills and knowledge of basic tools

- Must be willing and able to frequently push, pull, squat, bend, reach and lift up to 50lbs repeatedly through the course of the day without assistance; and maneuver and lift up to 200 lbs. repeatedly with assistance
